

The Dollar Game & Race to 100

Level 3

The game is designed for children 6 and 7 years old.

Two or 3 children play at a time with adult supervision.

If **The Dollar Game Level 2** is played and recorded on a record sheet, the carrying of the 1 indicates that 10 ONES were changed into 1 TEN and placed on the *Game Dollar*.

Now play **The Dollar Game Level 2** and record it to introduce the child to the notation used for carrying the 1.

As **The Dollar Game Level 2** is played and recorded, it clearly demonstrates to the child why a 1 is placed above the 10's column.

When playing either **Race to 100** or **The Dollar Game** at **Level 3**, the players first fill out the score sheet for each turn. This indicates the dice roll sum and the new position on the game board. The addition of the sum of the dice is verified by using the *1 to 20 Chart*. The new position on the game board is verified by counting the movement of the marker from the old position to the new position. The counting of the number of pennies on the *Game Dollar* verifies the increasing totals on **The Dollar Game** record sheet.
